Sponsorship/Eligibility Forms

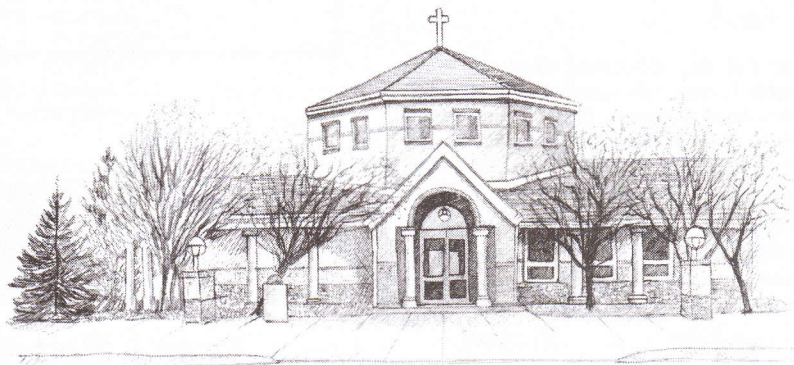

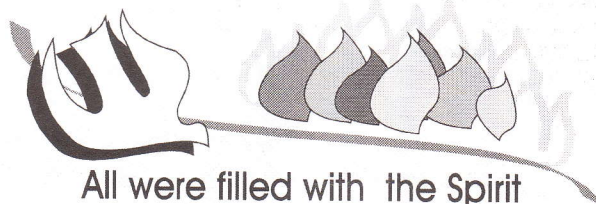

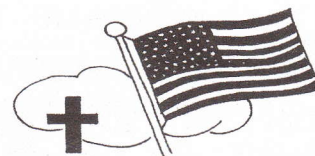
