


#### 2014 Bishop's Annual Appeal Life Changing Faith

#### MAY IS ASTHMA AWARENESS MONTH

#### What is asthma?

Asthma is a chronic disease in which the airways become inflamed or swollen. It can't be cured but can be controlled.

#### What are symptoms of asthma?

The main symptoms of an asthma attack are coughing, wheezing, chest tightness or trouble breathing.

#### What causes these attacks?

There are triggers that can cause an asthma attach to occur such as exercise, pollen, mold, animal dander, tobacco smoke, viral infections, and weather changes to name a few.

#### How is asthma treated?

Asthma cannot be cured but can be treated with medications. Some medications are inhaled and some can be taken as a pill. These medications come as two types, one if for quick relief during an asthma attack and the other are long-term control medications that help to prevent asthma attacks from occurring. Everyone with a diagnosis of asthma should have an **asthma action plan** that is written by your doctor to help control your asthma.
