Please join us Sunday, June 7, 2015 for our 11th annual Corpus Christi Procession, following the conclusion of the 10:45 Mass.

The Feast of Corpus Christi commemorates the institution of the Holy Eucharist. Catholics around the world celebrate the feast, by bringing the real presence to the world in a solemn procession, proclaiming our faith and our love for Jesus. Our procession will begin at the conclusion of Mass, with the Body of Christ being placed in the monstrance by the priest. As a parish family, we exit the church quietly. Cabot Street will be closed from St. Mary's to Ellis Square. The priest holding the monstrance will be under a canopy held by the Knights of Columbus. As we process down Cabot Street, we will respond aloud to prayers that will be led through a portable loudspeaker. We will process behind the YMCA and enter the driveway behind Saint Mary's. We will then have a brief benediction service.


