A Word from Fr. Andrew

Dear parishioners and friends,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, more traditionally known as Corpus Christi. For Catholic Christians it is a reminder that as we gather together at mass, and every time, that we receive the Body of Christ, we believe in His Real Presence. In other words, it is not just a symbol or a sign. We believe that Jesus Christ is truly present, body and blood, through the miraculous action at mass. All of this was instituted at the Passover meal celebrated by Christ 2000 years ago, which we call the Last Supper.

In reflecting upon that Last Supper, I think about the many artistic depictions that come to mind. Of course, there is the famous painting by da Vinci. One of my favorites is a beautiful rendering that hangs in the rectory which includes at the table, not only Jesus and his apostles, but women and children as well. There is also a fascinating masterpiece which I believe to be so relevant for the hectic paced everyday life of so many today. It is by the Italian Renaissance artist, Tintoretto. He depicts the Last Supper in an almost chaotic atmosphere. There are people milling about, everyone is talking, Judas of course, has a scowl on his face, there are children playing in the room, and you almost get the feeling that everyone is coming to the table, "AS IS"...exactly WHO and HOW they are.

Growing up and all through high school, I always remember that no matter what we were doing or where we were, my sister and I had to be at home for dinner at 5:30. It was a given, and it was just understood. Many times, we would run home in between afterschool activities, still in school uniforms, or looking like a hot, sweaty mess, running in from play or practice. But we were at the table. For me this is a reminder that we are all called to this table of our Lord each week, exactly how we are. Come from practice! Work! Come from the chaos of family life, come with your troubles and your woes and your excitement and your joys. Come to the table! Take! Eat! JUST COME!
