A Word from Fr. Andrew

Dear parishioners and friends,

**"It's a mystery"!** That always seems to be the stock answer when trying to explain something that is not easily understood in the church. So it is with the doctrine of the Trinity. Scholars far greater than any that I personally know have tried to define this doctrine by explaining just what it means to hold one Godhead in three individual persons. All being coequal, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit! And while it is a mystery, it can also be understood in a variety of other ways.

It is by faith that we believe that there are three persons in our one God. These persons are intertwined and are related as equal. So it is with our Trinitarian church. There is a connectedness with the three persons in one—just as there is a connectedness with all of us as members of one body, in Jesus Christ. Understanding the total doctrine of the Trinity may be difficult but the realization that we are all connected to one another, as well as to those persons in that one God, is essential to understanding our faith. This is a faith that reminds us that we are never alone and that we are connected one to another...we are connected to God. This is the same God who creates, who is the Father. This is the same God who redeems, namely the Son. This is the same God who sanctifies, called the Holy Spirit! Through our common baptism we are united to these three persons and to one another.
