Peace be with you! The Lord is Risen, Alleluia!

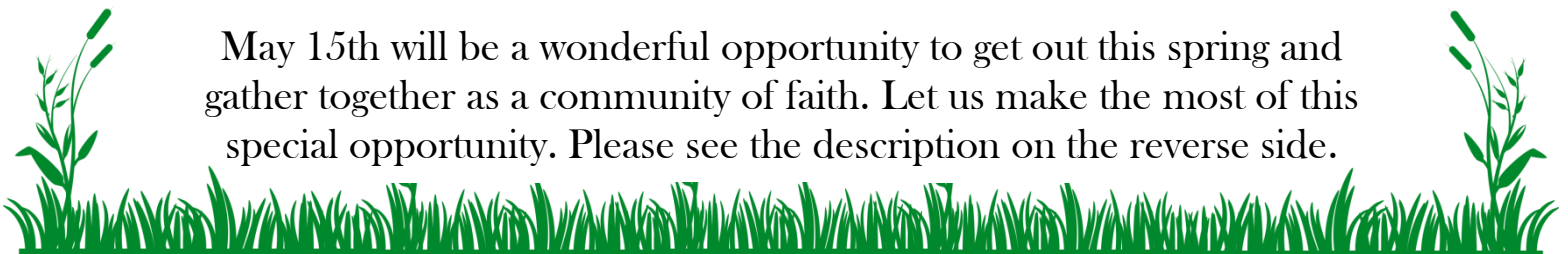
During this Easter Season of 50 days, we rejoice in our Risen Lord and are grateful for all he has done for us through His saving death and resurrection.
