Taizé is a monastic community located in Taizé, France, founded in the 1940s by Brother Roger. The brothers of Taizé are committed to a lifetime of simplicity, service, & community. A Taizé worship service involves sung and chanted prayers, meditation, a period of silence, liturgical readings, and icons. There is no preaching. On Pentecost Sunday – May 15th the Combined Music Ministries of Immaculate Conception and Divine Mercy Parishes will offer Evening Prayer in the style of Taize at 8pm at Immaculate Conception Church, 801 Taylor Avenue In Scranton. All of God's people from every denomination are welcome to join us for this beautiful experience of sung worship.
