Question of the week- Explain the feast Day of Mary, Mother of God: On New Year's Day, the octave day of Christmas, the church celebrates the Solemnity of the Holy Mother of God, the divine and virginal motherhood of the Blessed Virgin. It is the highest title of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Theotokos: Mother of God. This title was given to Mary at the Council of Ephesus in 431 A. D. The council taught, that the humanity and divinity of Jesus could not be separated and that they exist in one person.
