

Question of the week- Why does the Catholic Church believe that Christ is really present in the **Eucharist?** The Catholic Doctrine of the Real Presence is the belief that Jesus Christ is literally, not symbolically, present in the Holy Eucharist-body, blood, soul and divinity. Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist because Jesus tells us this is true in the Bible: "I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh." The Jews then disputed among themselves and asked how this could be? Jesus Said to them: "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you; he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day." The Doctrine of the Real Presence that Catholics believe today was believed by the earliest Christians 2,000 years ago.
