Question of the week-What is Confirmation? Confirmation completes Baptism by a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and enables the Christian for mission. This was seen at Pentecost with respect to the Apostles. In the early Church it was often accompanied by charismatic signs (speaking in tongues, gift of healing, prophecy, and others), though these are not intrinsic to the Sacrament. Conferred by the laying on of hands. In Acts 19:3-6 it is clear that John's baptism, Christian Baptism, and Confirmation are all distinct realities. Also, in Hebrews 6:2 baptizing and laying on of hands are distinguished.
