Question of the week: Where do we find the Chief truths of the Catholic Faith? We find the chief truths taught by Jesus Christ through the Catholic Church in the Apostles' Creed. The Creed is a summary or statement of what one believes. The "Creed" comes from the Latin word "Credo" which means "I believe"; that is, I accept or hold true something on the word of another. "I believe," with relation to the Apostles' Creed, means that I firmly assent to everything contained in it. The Apostles' Creed is so called because it has come down to us from Apostolic Times, and contains a *summary* of the *principal truths* taught by the Apostles.
