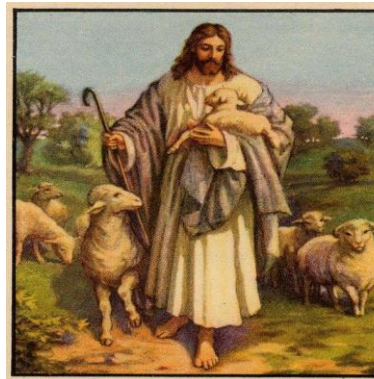

**Question of the Week – How can we and our children get more out of Mass?** Matthew Kelly says: "First, there needs to be a change in the way we approach Mass each Sunday. The Sunday liturgy is an opportunity for us to take time to listen. When does Sunday Mass begin for you? For me and my family, we take time out on Wednesday evenings to read through the readings, talk about what strikes us from each reading and why, and close with a spontaneous prayer. It takes about 15 minutes, but it places the readings of the upcoming Sunday in our minds several days before Mass. I encourage you all to try it!"
