

The current proposal for St. Peter's as of now is to be a "Clustered Parish" with St. Mary's/Sacred Heart in Norfolk. The definition for "clustered" is: two or more parishes collaborate on a common mission to serve those within a geographical area. They share personnel, resources, and programs, but they continue to exist as distinct parishes. They have their own parishioners, parish church and finances. They may share the same pastor, staff, and parish office. Other churches in the Rural Central Deanery may include Stand Alone: a traditional parish with its own pastor, parish church, finances, councils, staff and office. Consolidated Parishes: One parish retains its corporation and parish name while the other corporation is dissolved. The parish campus is used for as long as it continues to serve the mission.
