Question of the week-What is Viaticum? Is a term used especially in the Catholic Church for the Eucharist administered, with or without anointing of the sick, to a person who is dying, and is thus a part of the last rights. According to Cardinal Javier Lozano Barragan, the Catholic tradition of giving the Eucharist to the dying ensures that instead of dying alone, they die with Christ who promises them eternal life. The word "Viaticum" is a Latin word meaning "provision for a journey." The Eucharist is seen as the ideal spiritual food to strengthen a dying person for the journey from this world to life after death.
