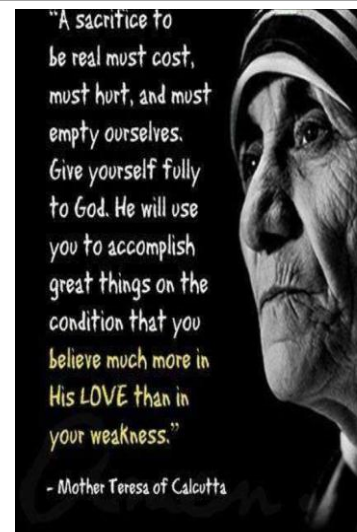

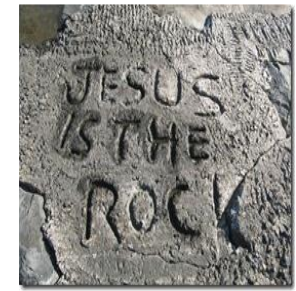
**\*Both the Bread and Wine will be offered at this weekend's Masses.**
