Question of the week: What is the symbolism of incensing the Casket at a funeral? Incense is always symbolic of our prayers rising to God. When a body is incensed, not only are we praying for the one who once occupied that body, but we are also praying that the soul of this person will "Rise to God" as the incense rises. Incense also is used as a sign of reverence, sanctification, and offering. So incensing the body is a way for the church to show its respect for the person who is being sent on their way to the Lord, and whose body will rise again on the last day. It's sort of a final giving over of self to God, assisted by the communion of Saints.
