**Question of the Week – How can we and our children get more out of Mass?**

**The Homily:** The average Homily lasts approximately seven minutes, and for many people this is the only exposure they have to religious education all week. The challenge the priest faces is to develop some point from the readings, and transform it into a powerful teaching moment. Jesus always met people where they were, and from there led them to a better life. The Homily is the priest's opportunity to convince people that Jesus has answers to the issues and questions they are struggling with. Engage: more often than not God uses a single phrase to speak to us. Listen. Stay open to what God might be trying to say to you. Also take time to discuss the Homily with your family.
