

Question of the Week - How can we and our children get more out of Mass? Understanding the Parts of Mass, and being engaged in them, is another way of getting more out of Mass. The Introductory Rites are: entrance procession and song, a greeting, the sign of the cross, the Penitential Act, the Gloria, and an opening prayer. Let's start with the Entrance Procession and song- Like every single part of the Mass, the opening song and procession have intended meaning. It is designed to bind us together as a community; to be united. The song is meant to lead our thoughts to the mystery of the particular feast or season. Engage: Make an effort to sing, or at least follow the words of the song, and reflect on how they comfort or even challenge you.
