Humble Pie: I like pie. Most of you know I like pie. However, a slice of Humble Pie usually isn't welcomed or sought after by most of us. I don't think it's on the menu at the Agawam Diner! There is a difference between being forced to eat a slice of Humble Pie and choosing to take a slice. Jesus chose to take a slice. He humbled Himself to come among us, as one of us. Jesus left behind the glories and power of heaven to become our servant, our redeemer. Jesus continues to humble Himself by taking on the appearance of bread and wine. The Holy Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Jesus. Not made so by the power of any human being, but by the power of love. Love can change things. Love can change us; the love that someone has for us, or the love that we choose to have for another. I hope you have had that experience. Humility enables a person to look beyond differences that might separate one person from another, and to love. Humility allows us to see each other the way God sees us. Jesus' humility allows simple things - bread and wine - to become Divine realities. This weekend we celebrate the gift of Corpus Christi - the Body and Blood of Jesus. As we reflect upon Jesus' humble presence in Holy Communion, it is a good moment to ask how we foster humility in our lives and, importantly, in our relationships. Some questions: Do we live lives open to a wisdom beyond our own cleverness or understanding? While striving to grow each day, are we at peace with our own limitations and at peace with others? Do we foster anger in our hearts? A daily slice of Humble Pie can help us grow in answering those questions as Jesus did. (...and there's no calories in Humble Pie.) See you at the Diner! Fr. 
