### PALM SUNDAY

#### **FAST AND ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS:**

Ash Wednesday, **March 1, 2017** and Good Friday, **April 14, 2017** are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence. Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older up to their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is observed by all 14 years old and older. No meat is allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not apply. When in doubt our pastor should be consulted.

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of renewal of baptism at Easter.

#### **REGLAS PARA EL AYUNO Y LA ABSTINENCIA**

El Miércoles de Ceniza, 1 de marzo de 2017 y el Viernes Santo, 14 de abril de 2017 son días de **ayuno** y **abstinencia**. Los viernes de cuaresma también son días de **abstinencia**.

**Ayuno** - debe ser observado por todas las personas de 18 hasta 59 años. Se permite una comida completa. Las otras dos comidas deben ser para sostenimiento nada más. No se permite comer entre comidas.

**Abstinencia** - debe ser observada por todas las personas de 14 años o más. No se permite comer carne. Si la salud o la capacidad para trabajar se afectan la ley no aplica. En caso de dudas en relación al ayuno y a la abstinencia, consulten al párroco.

Ayunar, dar limosna y orar son las tres disciplinas tradicionales de la Cuaresma. Debemos comprometernos sinceramente el llevar a cabo estas prácticas en un espíritu de penitencia y de preparación para la renovación del bautismo en la Pascua.
