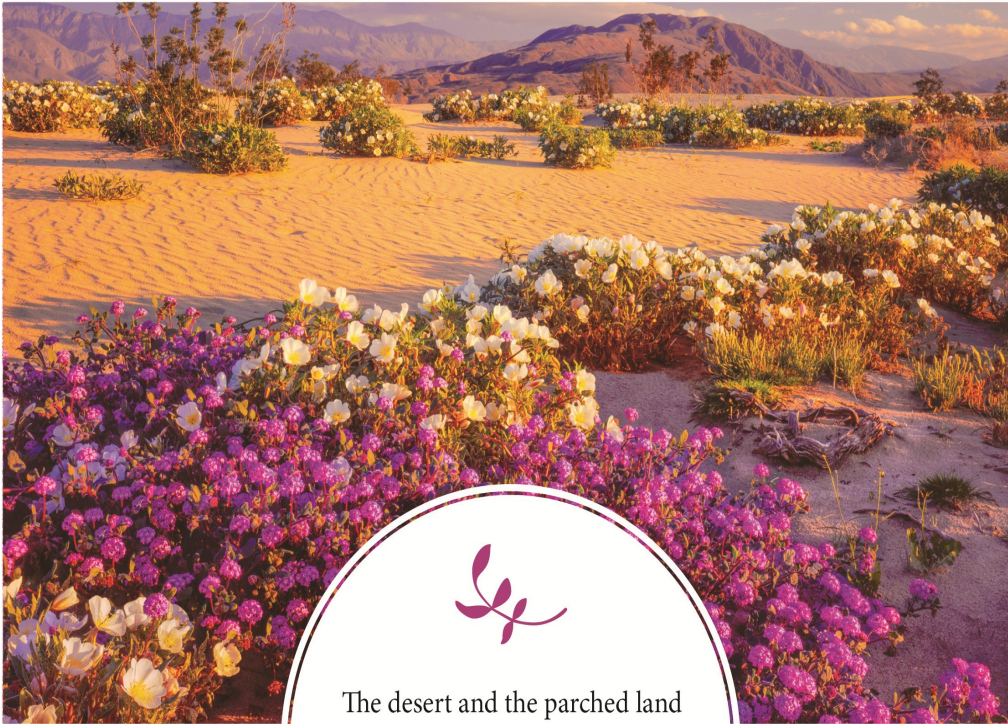
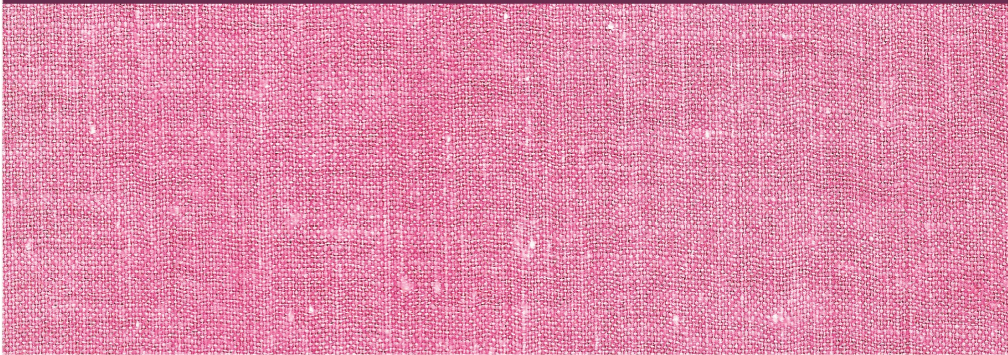

THE ADVENT CALENDAR

It seems that German Lutherans were the first to count down the Advent days to Christmas, taking December 1st as their starting point, thereby avoiding the fluctuating date of Advent's beginning with the fourth Sunday before Christmas. Chalk marks on the doorpost counted the twenty four days until Christmas. It is not until the beginning of the twentieth century that printed Advent calendars made their appearance. Today, Advent calendars can range from the purely secular (with a Santa image and a small piece of chocolate behind a door for each day) to the overtly religious, in which the opening of each day's door reveals a Scripture verse pointing to the Christmas feast. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has an online Advent calendar with links to daily Scripture readings and suggested family activities.

Parece que los luteranos alemanes fueron los primeros en contar los días de Adviento a la Navidad, tomando el 1 de diciembre como su punto de partida, evitando así la fluctuante fecha de inicio del Adviento con el cuarto domingo de antes de Navidad. Marcas de tiza en la jamba contaron los veinte cuatro días hasta Navidad. No es hasta principios del siglo XX que los calendarios de Adviento hicieron su aparición. Hoy, calendarios de Adviento pueden ir desde los puramente secular (con una imagen de Santa y un pequeño trozo de chocolate detrás de una puerta para cada día) hasta la abiertamente religioso, en el que la apertura de la puerta de cada día muestra un versículo de las escrituras sobre la fiesta de Navidad. La Conferencia de obispos católicos de Estados Unidos tiene un calendario de Adviento en línea con enlaces a lecturas bíblicas diarias y actividades sugeridas.
