SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In another passage from his Sermon on the Mount, Jesus continues to turn his disciples' way of thinking upside-down. One of the lessons for the Christian steward in today's Gospel is that if we have a chance to help someone in need, we should be generous and give more than is expected of us. Jesus went "the extra mile" for us. Can we be more like Jesus and "go the extra mile" for others?

En otro pasaje de su Sermón de la Montaña, Jesús continúa transformando la manera de pensar de sus discípulos enfocándolos hacia una nueva perspectiva. Una de las lecciones para el cristiano responsable en el Evangelio de hoy, es que si nosotros tenemos la oportunidad de ayudar a alguien en necesidad, debemos ser generosos y dar más de lo que se espera de nosotros. Jesús recorrió la "milla extra" por nosotros. ¿Podemos nosotros ser como Jesús y "recorrer la milla extra" por otros?

NOT ASKING THE IMPOSSIBLE

The final line in today's Gospel can seem confusing: "be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect." "Perfect" is sometimes imagined as "flawless," as in a flawless diamond. But the Greek word used here, as used elsewhere in the New Testament, means something different: to become mature, whole, or healthy.

Jesus is not asking us to be flawless, nor does he want us to say, "Well, that's impossible, why bother then?" He is inviting us to grow into full Christian maturity. For most of us, Jesus' words in today's Gospel are very challenging. We need to resist the temptation to dodge his challenge by calling it impossible.

SIN PEDIR LO IMPOSIBLE

La línea final en el Evangelio de hoy puede parecer confusa: "Sed perfectos, como vuestro Padre celestial es perfecto". "Perfecto" se imagina a veces como "impecable", como un diamante sin defectos.

Pero la palabra griega usada aquí, como en otros lugares en el nuevo testamento, significa algo diferente: ser maduro, entero o sano.

Jesús no nos pide que sea perfecta, ni quiere decir, "Bueno, eso es imposible, ¿por qué molestarse entonces?" Él se nos invita a crecer en madurez plena cristiana. Para la mayoría de nosotros, las palabras de Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy son muy difíciles.

Tenemos que resistir la tentación de esquivar su desafío llamando a imposible.
