

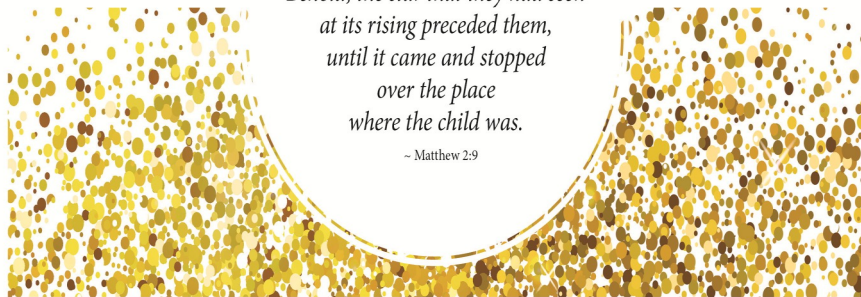

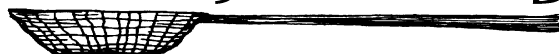

The Star of Bethlehem / La Estrella de Belen

Almost every year at Christmastime, you can find a newspaper article or TV documentary about the star of Bethlehem. Astronomers give various theories about whether the magi saw a supernova, or a comet, or a conjunction of two or more planets. But for us, the star has a deeper meaning.

In Matthew's Gospel, light is used as a symbol of the good news of Jesus coming into the world. That's why verse 9 of the Gospel has the image of the star preceding the wise men and stopping over the house where Jesus was. By following the star, they become followers of Christ. So what do the magi show us about following Jesus? First, they take the initiative. They saw the star, figured out what it meant, and made their journey. As followers of Jesus, we can look for what needs to be done (in our family, parish, or community) and do it.

Second, they expressed their faith in Jesus by the gifts they brought: gold—a gift for a king, who is worthy to be followed; frankincense—Jesus is worthy to be worshiped as Son of God; and myrrh—Jesus becomes king by dying for us all. We can express our faith in many ways. We can volunteer to help the poor, the elderly, or the disabled. We can teach our children how to pray and tell them about all that God has done for us.

Third, they were not afraid to take risks for Jesus. How often do we take risks for the Lord, by openly speaking about our faith, or giving God credit for the good that we do? Let the star of Bethlehem remind us that Jesus is the star of our lives. JS Paluch

Casi todos los años en Navidad, usted puede encontrar un artículo periodístico o documental de TV sobre la estrella de Belén. Astrónomos dan diversas teorías acerca de si magi vio una supernova o un cometa o una conjunción de dos o más planetas. Pero para nosotros, la estrella tiene un significado más profundo. En el Evangelio de Mateo, la luz se utiliza como un símbolo de la buena noticia de Jesús que entra en el mundo. Por eso el versículo 9 del Evangelio tiene la imagen de la estrella anterior a los Reyes Magos y dejar la casa donde Jesús estaba. Siguiendo la estrella, se convierten en seguidores de Cristo. Por lo tanto, ¿qué los Reyes Magos nos muestra acerca de seguir a Jesús? En primer lugar, toman la iniciativa. Ver la estrella, averiguado lo que significaba y hecho su viaje. Como seguidores de Jesús, para buscar lo que necesita realizarse (en nuestra familia, parroquia o comunidad) y hacerlo.

En segundo lugar, expresaron su fe en Jesús por los regalos que trajeron: oro, un regalo para un rey, que es digno a seguir; incienso — Jesús es digno de ser adorado como hijo de Dios; y mirra, Jesús se convierte en rey muriendo por todos nosotros. Podemos expresar nuestra fe de muchas maneras. Podemos voluntariamente ayudar a los pobres, los ancianos o los discapacitados. Podemos enseñar a nuestros hijos cómo rezar y contarles todo lo que Dios ha hecho por nosotros. En tercer lugar, no tenían miedos de tomar riesgos para Jesús. ¿Con qué frecuencia tomamos riesgos para el Señor, abiertamente hablando de nuestra fe, o dando crédito de Dios para el bien que hacemos? Que la estrella de Belén nos recuerdan que Jesús es la estrella de nuestras vidas.
