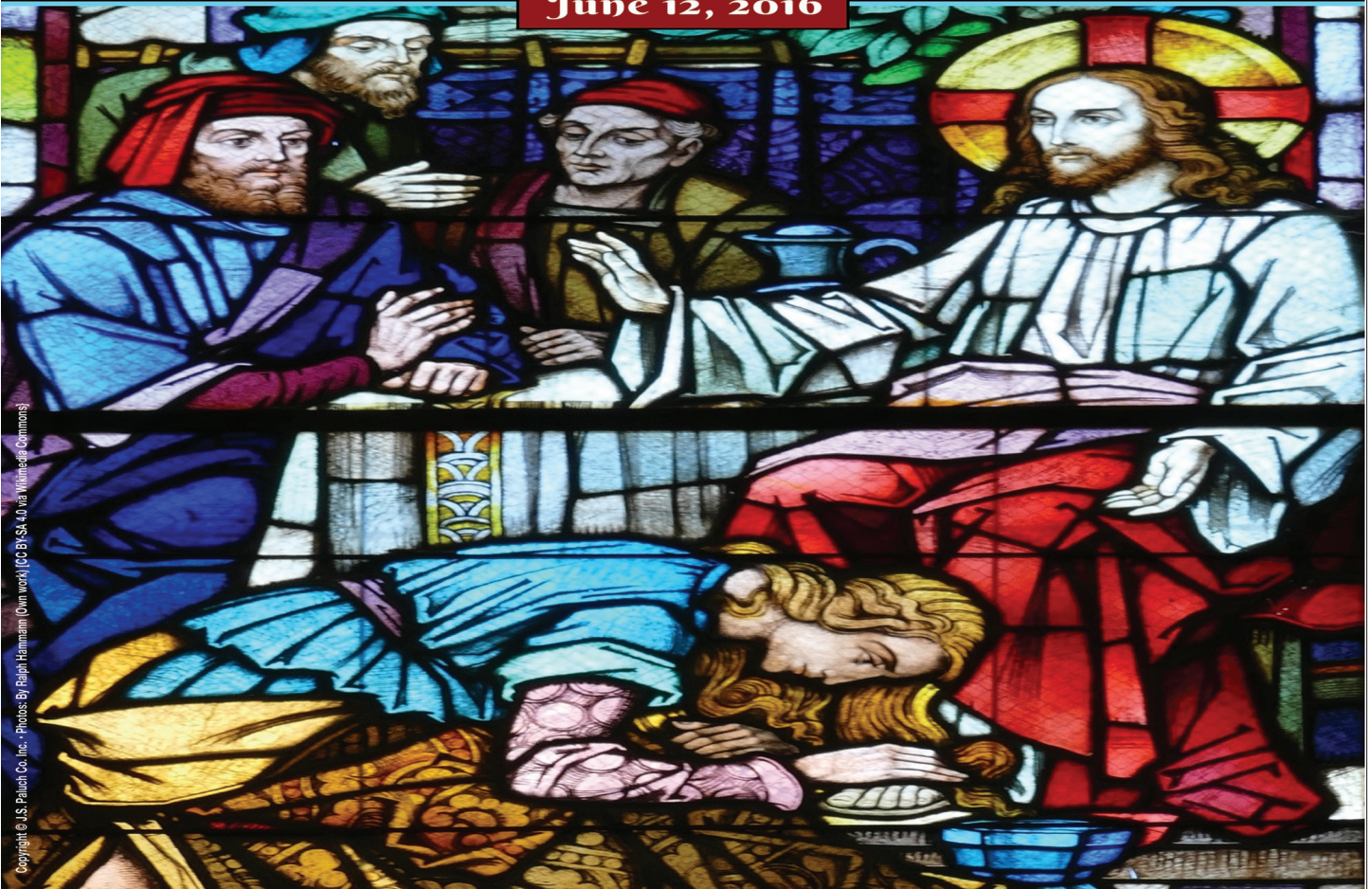

Safeguarding your faith

How can a Catholic best safeguard his faith? A Catholic can best safeguard his faith by making frequent acts of faith, by praying for a strong faith, by studying his religion very earnestly, by living a good life, by good reading, by refusing to associate with the enemies of the Church, and by not reading books and papers opposed to the Church and her teaching.

Jubilee Year of Mercy
Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

On today's *Jubilee for Those Sick and Suffering Disabilities*, Jesus encounters a woman who is "spiritually ill." She is thus "disabled" from participating in Israel's worshiping community or polite society. Bathing Jesus' feet with tears, drying them with unveiled hair, anointing them (Luke 7:38) risk Jesus' becoming "unclean." Yet his mercy welcomes even such inappropriate behavior as her sincere manifestation of love: "Your sins are forgiven. Go in peace" (7:48, 50). Go not just in "peace," but in *shalom*, the all-enveloping, life-changing assurance of God's mercy. She is anonymous, "known in the city" only as "a sinful woman" (7:37). The character with name and religious title, "Simon the Pharisee" (7:36, 40), judges her harshly, but himself not at all, and thus forfeits God's mercy. This *Jubilee Year of Mercy* challenges us to self-examination. In which role do we most often cast ourselves, humble sinner or judgmental Pharisee? Jesus declares that only by an unfailing willingness to show mercy to fellow sinners can we hope to obtain mercy ourselves see *Misericordiae Vultus*, 9). Peter Scagnelli, Copyright © J. S. HOPE AND FORGIVENESS

There were some interesting conceptions of sin prevalent in the time of the Hebrew scriptures. There was the belief that God punished sin immediately. Those who suffered disease or misfortune were, therefore, sinners getting their due from the Almighty.

Today's first reading hints at another kind of God. When David admits his sin, Nathan declares, "The LORD on his part has forgiven your sin" (2 Samuel 12:13b). Here was not a vengeful God but a merciful God. What good news that must have been to David and those who, like him, could be honest enough to admit their sinfulness!

Jesus is the good news of God's mercy and forgiveness incarnate. Without Jesus, perhaps the good news would have been too good to believe, too difficult to imagine. But there he is in today's Gospel, the God-man, forgiving a sinner and declaring that she is forgiven because of her great love.

There is hope, then, for the rest of us sinners, if only we love enough!

Año Jubilar de la Misericordia
Undécimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

El Jubileo de hoy para aquellos discapacitados que sufren por enfermedad. Jesús se encuentra con una mujer que es "espiritualmente enferma." Ella es, pues, "desabilitada" de participar en el culto de la comunidad de Israel o de la buena sociedad. Bañar los pies con lágrimas, secarlos con el cabello descubierto, y unjirlos (Lucas 7:38) arriesga a Jesús a convertirse en "impuro", sin embargo, su misericordia da la bienvenida a su comportamiento inapropiado y a su sincera manifestación de amor: "Tus pecados te son perdonados. Vete en paz" (7:48, 50). Vete, no sólo en "paz", pero en *Shalom*, el total envolvente, cambio de vida le garantiza la misericordia de Dios. Ella tiene el sinonimo, "conocido en la ciudad" sólo como "una mujer pecadora" (07:37). El personaje con el nombre y título religioso, "Simón el fariseo" (7:36, 40), la juzga con dureza, pero no se juzga a sí mismo y por lo tanto perdiere la misericordia de Dios. Este año jubilar de la Misericordia nos desafía a un auto examen. Cual es el papel en el que más a menudo nos colocamos nosotros mismos, humilde pecador o fariseo crítico? Jesús declara que sólo por una voluntad inquebrantable de mostrar misericordia a compañeros pecadores, podremos esperar obtener la misericordia de nosotros mismos. ESPERANZA Y PERDON

Hubo algunos conceptos interesantes del pecado que prevalecen en el momento de las escrituras hebreas. Existía la creencia de que Dios castigaba el pecado inmediatamente. Las personas que sufrieron la enfermedad o la desgracia eran, por lo tanto, los pecadores y pagaban así su deuda a El Todopoderoso.

La primera lectura de hoy nos habla de otra clase de Dios. Cuando David admite su pecado, Nathan declara: "El Señor por su parte ha perdonado tu pecado" (2 Samuel 12: 13b). Aquí nos muestra no un Dios vengativo, sino un Dios misericordioso. Qué buena noticia debe haber sido para David y los que, como él, son lo suficientemente honestos para admitir su pecado!

Jesús es la buena noticia de la misericordia y el perdón de Dios encarnado. Sin Jesús, tal vez la buena noticia habría sido demasiado buena para creer, demasiado difícil de imaginar. Pero ahí está en el Evangelio de hoy, el Dios-hombre, que perdona a un pecador y declara que ella es perdonada a causa de su gran amor.
