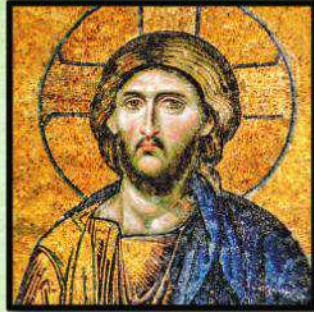
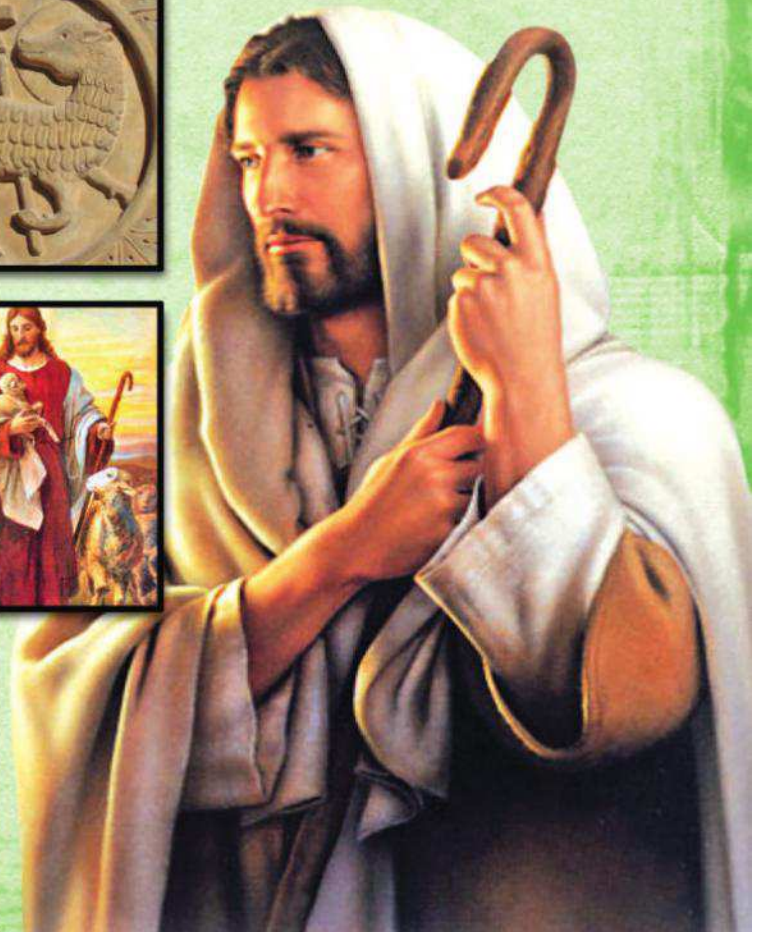

### When are we going?

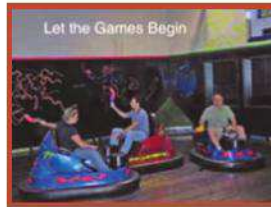
We are scheduled to go on Friday, January 23. We will meet in the Village Church parking lot at 5:30pm and we should be back around 9:30pm.

## Thoughts on the Spirituality Journey: Faith to Wisdom

We lack the language to express the knowing of God that exists. The only way we seem to be able to express this knowing is through **metaphoric language**. "It is like..." It is like the encounter between Moses and God. It is like "the bush that burns but is never consumed." Moses can only respond by removing his shoes because he is on holy ground. Again the best we can do is approximate and thus the metaphor. How often do we realize, at the time or in retrospect, that we are or have been on Holy Ground? My own language for those times is what I call "God Moments." When we reflect upon those moments, how difficult it is for us to put into words the deeper experience that took place. It is often just a "Knowing" of which words fall short to describe.
