<u>From the desk of</u> <u>Pastoral Associate Fran Taylor</u> <u>You Are a Disciple Sent</u> <u>by the Holy Spirit</u>

On this feast of Pentecost, we remember the apostles and other disciples in the upper room wondering what comes next. Last weekend, we presented the draft of the Pastoral Plan to the Collaborative and I'm sure there are many who are wondering "what's next?" The answer is the same to both questions. The Holy Spirit sends you forth, just like the apostles, to spread the good news. Do you ever feel the Holy Spirit working within you?
