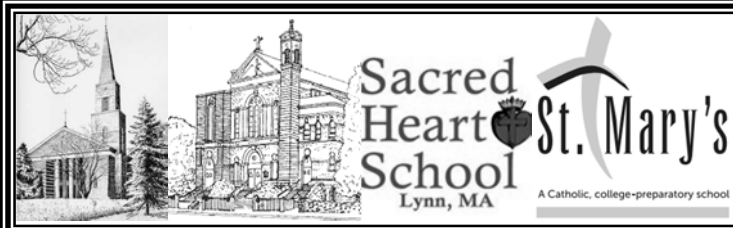

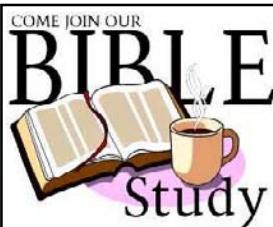

How Do We Welcome?

These past few weeks, we have been asking people to step out of their comfort zones and introduce themselves to the people in the pews around them. How has this made you feel? For some, it seems strange, for others, it is great to get to know the names of the people they see each week. But what about when we're not in church and pushed to be welcoming? In the past, people knew their neighbors and would reach out to those new to the neighborhood. Are we happy when someone new is in "our" bench? Do we smile at the youth who come to church even if we don't like what they wear, or how they choose to decorate themselves? Do you remember the first time you walked into a new church – or new neighborhood? Did you feel judged or welcomed? Jesus told his disciples that there were more sheep that were not of "this fold" that he had come to save and that the goal was to have one fold with the one shepherd. It is everyone's responsibility to help this happen. It may be the new neighbor, it may be the person checking out the friendliness of our community, it may even be a member of your family or circle of friends that needs a welcome either for the first time, or as an encouragement to return. We all know the benefit of a welcoming smile. Remember, smiling uses fewer muscles than frowns, so if you want fewer wrinkles, SMILE! You are welcome.

This week I am on a Cursillo Team at the Holy Cross Fathers' Retreat House located at Stonehill College in Easton. Fr. Frank and I both have a long history with this Retreat Center and each offer our time to the center once a year or so.

Cursillo is a Spanish word meaning "short course" and the Cursillo retreat is a short course in Christianity that runs from Thursday evening through Sunday night. It is a great way to discover what God is calling you to in your life and offers the opportunity for all to deepen their relationship with Christ. I have never known anyone to come back from a Cursillo without discovering something new about themselves. The beauty of the retreat is it is for all, no matter where you are in your spiritual life or how much you know or don't know about the faith, the Lord will make the retreat a special time for you, often providing you with exactly what you need at this stage in your life. If you wish to know more please do not hesitate to speak with Fr. Fran, Fr. Tamiru or me for additional information.

Many thanks to all who contributed so generously to our emergency Winter Maintenance collections. This will truly help us in paying for the additional bills because of the harsh winter as well as make up for some of the lost collection money due to the storms falling on the weekends. We do ask that whenever you cannot attend Mass at our churches for one reason or another that you continue to offer your weekly donations. Weekly offertory is a key source of our yearly income and is counted upon when we build our annual budget. When offertory is not as we have planned on we need to make difficult decisions in an attempt to keep our parishes operating without going into debt.

I also wish to thank all those who have contributed to this year's Catholic Appeal. One hundred and forty six donors from St. Mary's have pledged \$25,218 towards our goal of \$28,852. This puts us at 87% of our goal. Sacred Heart has pledged \$16,382 from 104 donors. This brings us to 75% of our goal of \$21,919. I once again ask all members of our parishes to prayerfully consider what they can offer to the Appeal. Even the small donations quickly add up and will help us and the diocese reach its target as we seek to provide services to so many in the Church of Boston. Once again thank you for your generosity.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul assists anyone within our conference boundaries who is in need of help. Most requests for assistance are for rent, oil, utility bills, food, clothing or furniture. Upon receiving a request for assistance, a pair of society members visits those in need in their home to see how we can help.

We like to thank the parishioners of Sacred Heart and St. Mary Collaborative who aid us in this ministry by their generous donations each week to the Saint Vincent de Paul Society at the doors of the church, our annual envelope drive, spiritual bouquets and our September "Walk for the Poor".

100% of the funds donated by you are used to assist those in need.

Last year **Sacred Heart Conference** assisted 201 families (597 peopled helped), and spent \$38,190. Our 18 members donated 2,735 hours of service.

Last year **Saint Mary Conference** assisted 693 families (2,772 peopled helped), and spent \$32,134. Our 12 members donated 2,894 hours of service.

Needs are as great as ever. The demand is not easing. Any donation will help us to help others in need. Members of St. Vincent will pass out envelopes at the exits. These envelopes can be deposited at any Mass, any weekly collection, or mailed to the office 8 South Common Street. We are also eligible to receive corporate matching gifts.

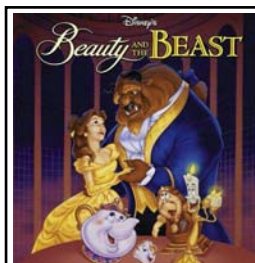
TROOP 34 FUNDRAISER
