

#### <u>From the desk of</u> <u>Pastoral Associate Fran Taylor</u>

<u>Trust God in The Storms of</u> <u>Your Life</u>

Trust is an interesting concept. Who do you trust? Some people will answer, "ME." They have trouble trusting anyone other than themselves. How lonely that must be! Some put their trust in the wrong people and are hurt in the bargain. But in the truly important times, the difficult times, it is important to know who we can trust. I often speak to parents coming to have their children baptized about the importance of helping them develop a relationship with God. That it is their responsibility to make sure that they know that Jesus is always there for them. Most of us have had friends who told us that we could rely on them, but many of them have moved away, become busy with their own lives and families and are no longer a part of our daily lives. Would they be there when we do need them? Would we be there for them? God is always there. Jesus is the one friend that will never move away or become too busy to be around when we need him. Our problem is often that WE have become too busy for God and doubt. The remedy, of course, is not to lose touch with God but to talk with him daily, share our joys and sorrows, pains and pleasures, our dreams and our fears. Then, when the winds howl and the waves are trying to swamp the boats of our lives, we can trust that our faithful companion is with us in that boat and will see us through even the darkest storms.


