



HEALING PRAYER LAST WEDNESDAY OF **EACH MONTH**

We Are Saved Through The Blood of Christ

We have been redeemed. Jesus paid the price so that our sins could be forgiven and we would be able to enjoy eternal life with God. There is nothing we can do to make up for our sins. Salvation is a pure gift from God thanks to the sacrifice that Jesus made out of love for us. So, if salvation is a gift and we don't earn eternal life by our own merits, then what are we supposed to do? Listen to some of the words of today's psalm. "How shall I make a return to the Lord for all the good he has done for me? The cup of salvation I will take up, and I will call upon the name of the Lord....I will offer sacrifice of thanksgiving...my vows to the Lord I will pay." These words really spoke to me this week as there have been many times over the years that I have "bargained" with God! Please, God, if you will do this for me than I will do this for you! Have you ever said something like that? More to the point, have you followed through? I know that there have been times when I have failed to follow through on the promises I have made but God has never failed me. He may not have answered my pleas in the manner I wished, but he always answered in the way that was best for me in the long run. It's good to be reminded to say "thank you" more often for the great gift that is salvation. It is good to reflect on the Eucharist we celebrate and receive. We are partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ. Just as the apostles at the Last Supper, we don't always understand what Jesus was doing, but we know enough so that we should never take this gift for granted.

LYNN CATHOLIC SCHOOLS \$1,000 SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE

One \$1,000 scholarship is available toward tuition at each Sacred Heart School, St. Mary's Junior High, and St. Pius V School. Applications are available at any of the three schools' administrative offices after June 8.

- 3. Application is time sensitive. Applicant must apply, be accepted, enroll, and submit scholarship application by **Friday**, **June 19, 2015**, for the 2015-2016 school year.
