Fr. Kevín's Reflection

Since Jesus Christ Is the Founder ... His Catholic Church is the Perfect Faith

As a Catholic, you, by His Mercy (not your willing it) are on the most winning team of all ... a team that was brought together by the Son of God and continues to be coached by the Holy Spirit of God. The Hall of Fame located in Heaven is filled with millions of outstanding players called the Saints and (if we desire), we can share the playing field with them everyday ... if we want?

It's enough to make you want to stand up and cheer for "Ole Notre Dame" (which by the way is Latin for "Our Lady"). If we truly realized what a championship team God has given us in His Church, we would carry the excitement of being on winning team in such a way that others would want to join the team.

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI wants us to do just that, which is why he declared "Year of Faith" in 2013! He said: "Faith commits every one of us to become a living sign of the presence of the Risen Lord in the world. 
Natural Family Planning Awareness July 19-25, 2015
