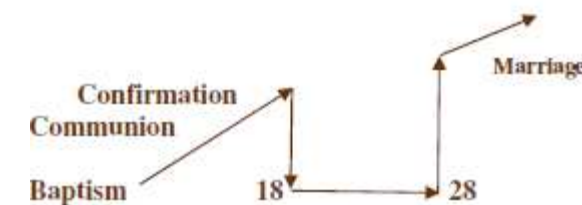

Fr. Kevin's Reflection

I'm hearing some sad news from parents (that I typically hear every year about this time) that they suspect or know that their college age children, who are working away from home, are not going to Sunday Mass as they were! Whether their young adults are actually away at college or off somewhere working, they're experiencing a phenomenon that is referred to as "**The Valley of Spiritual Death**". It's that time where kids are away from the watchful eye of their parents and they decide they'll either not go to Church or they'll go with friends to a non-Catholic church. In doing so, these few Confirmed members of the Church are setting aside **their Catholic faith** and may not reclaim it until years later when they get married, or have children to be baptized or receive First Communion.



Now here's some **amazing gallop poll statistics:**

1. In families where **just the Mom** practices her faith, only **45%** of children will come back to the Church.
2. In families where **the Dad** practices his faith, (regardless of whether or not the Mom did), **95%** of children come back to the Church!

*** That's a **50% difference in return to the Faith!** ***

Yes, God designed **the Husband** to be **the spiritual head of the family**, with the **authority** and **responsibility** to guide his **wife** and **children** all the way home to heaven ... and when he doesn't fulfill **his role** by faithfully going to Mass, he jeopardizes the salvation of **his whole family!** So, **Dads**, recognize the great responsibility you have ... and that you must persist in modeling your Catholic faith so that your children will remain on the road to Heaven. And, **Moms**, be tireless in your support of your husbands to start them or sustain them in attending Sunday Mass. There's a lot at stake ... so keep the faith! And, sincerely, may God bless you to be steadfast in your faith!

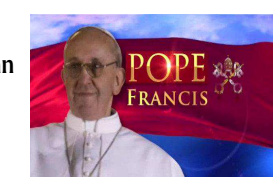
