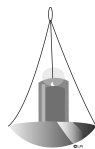

*Some random thoughts by the pastor ...*

We can easily become 'stuck' and not know that we are 'spinning our wheels'... including in our religious beliefs. As children we are influenced by our parents, our teachers, and our society in such a way that we readily accept 'a point-of-view' without knowing that we have. None of this is bad. The influence (operating on an unconscious level), however, prevents us from knowing that God walks with us, as the Risen Christ walks with the two disciples in today's gospel story from Luke. Most often, we need a significant shock to disrupt the way that we view life, God and ourselves. The crucifixion is enough of a shock to cause the disciples to be DISILLUSIONED, i.e. for their 'oh-so-neat' point-of-view to be undermined, allowing disappointment and questions to come to the surface. One of the accepted truths of our youth is that certitude is good and doubts are bad; answers are good and questions are bad. Jesus helps the disciples to see a different 'point-of-view' in which doubts and questions are necessary for 'our eyes to be opened.' God is good.

**Parish updates:** Some events that are right around the corner: First Communion will be celebrated at the 10:00 Mass on Sunday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Confirmation will also be celebrated on May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3:00 in the Cathedral (SS. Peter & Paul). Our annual May Breakfast will take place on Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup> in the church hall. Steve is preparing the rectory and the garage for the painter. We hope to have an approximate date when they will begin soon. The church hall will be washed and waxed next week. Some of the outside projects that are on our list are: scraping and re-painting around the church windows; mulching; painting the exterior of the (former) school building; and various other oddities that seem to present themselves.
