Some random thoughts by the pastor ...

Our second reading (from the First Letter of John) and our Gospel (from John) raise the question, 'Who are we?' We often determine who we are by using several indicators such as skin color, sexual orientation, and economic status. (Naturally, there are numerous other indicators too, such as, ethnic background, intelligence, business success, and some negative indicators too, such as, being abused, having an impediment, experiencing devastating lost at an early age.) Though these indicators do tell us who we are, they are too limited to provide us with enough information. They are too incomplete to provide us with a complete picture. The question: 'Who are we?' is answered differently by the First Letter of John and the Gospel of John. They both tell us that the most complete answer (which contains all other answers) is: we are created by God in the 'image and likeness of God'. When we willingly practice knowing ourselves in this way, we begin to see that the other indicators though sometimes important - are insignificant in light of the indicator that encompasses them all. God is good.

Parish updates: First Communion will be celebrated at the 10:00 Mass next Sunday, May 3rd. Confirmation will also be celebrated next Sunday at 3:00 in the Cathedral (SS. Peter & Paul). Our annual May Breakfast will take place on Sunday, May 17th in the church hall. We received word from the company who was scheduled to re-paint the rectory. They have informed us that they are unable to do the job. This means that we will have to re-bid the job and, most likely, the job will not be undertaken until the fall.
