Some random thoughts by the pastor ...

Isn't it maddening when everything works out when we have decided that it won't work out? Peter and the other disciples of Jesus are adamant that certain requirements be fulfilled BEFORE people are free to know that God is one with them. Then, without any of these requirements being fulfilled the Gentile family of Cornelius experiences the freedom to know that God dwells with them. (The story in the Acts of the Apostles speaks of the 'Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening.') Peter and those who are with him are aghast! James and the community living in Jerusalem take Peter to task for entering the house of a Gentile and then for his acknowledging God's presence with them. Judging seeks to prevent God from loving us as God desires to love us. It doesn't feel as good (sometimes) not judging, but practicing a willingness not to judge prepares the way for us to experience with some chagrin - God loving us and others in unexpected (and sometimes undesired) ways. God is good.
