Some random thoughts by the pastor ...

We wear red this weekend. Usually when we wear red it is because we are remembering the shedding of blood (as with a martyr). This weekend the red is symbolic of fire. The Spirit is often associated with fire. The two disciples, for example, who were on their way to Emmaus recall after they recognize the Risen Christ, 'Did not our hearts burn?' Fire is also a symbol used by numerous writers (including John of the Cross and Thérèse of Lisieux) to describe the love that they have come to know. Fire, as it consumes, transforms the material burning into itself. It is this process that is used as the symbol of the Spirit who transforms our humanity into divinity. God is good.

Thanks, too, to the Boy Scouts and their leaders who served and did a great job cleaning the church hall and kitchen.
