Some random thoughts by the pastor ...

Our first reading from the Book of Deuteronomy captures for us - for the better part - the way in which we understand and relate with God. The reading speaks of the mighty deeds of God that prove that YHWH is God. It is - primarily - a contractual understanding in which God's goodness to us is dependent upon our keeping the points (commandments) of the contract. Hence, the reading encourages a BUSINESS RELATIONSHIP. A business relationship is very different than a personal relationship. The binding of a business relationship is the fulfillment of the contract. The binding of a personal relationship is love. We can keep the commandments, live a moral life, be a daily Mass goer and not know love (i.e. live as an isolated individual). This is possible because the human tendency (temptation) is to live independently and autonomously. God is inter-dependent (relational). We - in Christian theology - express this reality when we speak of God as Trinity. The relationship that exists between God and Jesus the Christ (as happens with each relation that comes forth from love) is a third life (which we call the Holy Spirit). This is who God is, and who we are, and who we are becoming. God is good.

Parish updates: Father Tom O'Neil is with us this weekend. I am attending the graduation of my greatnephew, Cameron. We have had another Girl Scout Troup interested in using the Parish Center. We are still awaiting the energy report from RISE. The rectory will need to purchase a new refrigerator. (I can no longer find a company who delivers ice!) Work on the grounds continues...
