The mystery of growth and development - even when we scientifically dissect it - eludes us. identify the mechanics. We can classify the ingredients. We can clone the process. Jesus seems to be saying something similar in today's gospel story from Mark. The seed is scattered and then allowed to grow and develop in whatever way that it grows and develops.
