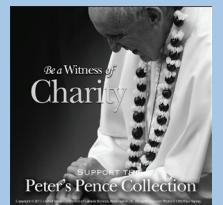

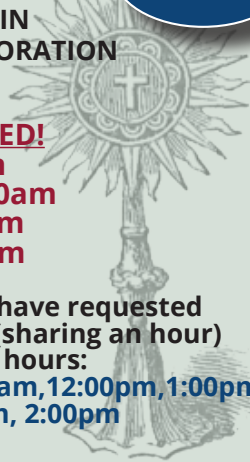

# Staff Stories. . .



## GIVING

Having a GENEROUS SPIRIT and GIVING TO OTHERS takes many forms here at St. Patrick, where our giving is not only INTENTIONAL, but is GENEROUS beyond comparison! As longtime parishioners, my husband Bob and I have personally witnessed that generosity as a parish and as individuals in an endless number of ways.

## GIVING AS A PARISH

What many may not realize is that not only do the parishioners of St. Patricks provide time, talent, and treasure to help individuals in need (as well as the organizations that serve them), but we as a parish tithe throughout the year. The word tithe means "one tenth" and even more than just a tenth, it is to be the "First Fruits" of all we have received. In 2017-2018 alone we tithed \$177,200! This week's bulletin cover highlights those organizations we contribute to through our parish tithe and gives us the opportunity to think about why we tithe as a parish and how we choose who to support. The parish tithing process begins with a proposed list which is presented to the Pastoral Council for it's review and approval. The organizations presented must share our values, philosophies, and our mission... "love our neighbor as our self."

This year three new organizations were introduced and added to the list:

### Dwelling Place:

Transitional Christian housing for women and their children leaving abusive situations.

### Eagles Healing Nest:

Housing and services for homeless veterans and their families.

### AVIVO:

Treatment and housing for adults and their children coping with dependency or mental health issues.

## GIVING AS AN INDIVIDUAL OR FAMILY

Many years ago, Bob and I had the opportunity to hear a couple give witness to the impact tithing had had on their lives. It was a talk we have never forgotten. It was a couple who had 2 young children and had just found out they were going to have twins. Their finances were rocky at best, even before they had received the news. They could not imagine being able to afford diapers and formula for 4! They looked at their finances and thought they could trim their expenses in some areas, but it would have to include their tithing. As luck would have it, they had received the news during their parish's stewardship campaign. They heard their pastor give a very moving talk about his own tithing experience and about how we are asked to giving freely and trust that the Lord will provide. They decided to take the leap and tithe the 10% we are asked to give. At first it was 10% of their net income and they found that they were still able to pay their bills and provide for all their family's needs. Then they decided to tithe 10% of their gross! They found the benefits to be bountiful.. God did provide and gave them many blessings and graces for their steadfast trust in HIM.

When we tithe of our income, it shows that our heart isn't tied to our money and that we love God more than our money. St. Paul asks, "What do you have that has not been given to you?" What if we could think of tithing as an OPPORTUNITY to give out of joy and a wish to share God's many blessings?

As Father Tim Nolan once said,  
" Everything belongs to the Lord, it is not how much should I give you Lord, it is how much can I keep?"

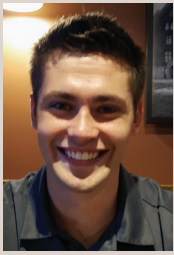

### Pick of the Week

### This week's Pick is God's Will.

As one of God's much loved sons and daughters, we can be assured that God has a unique plan for our life—a role that is ours alone

in His great plan of Salvation. But how can we know for certain whether or not we are following God's Will? Short of having one of God's messengers pay a visit, we can't and won't know for certain, but there are ways we can get a clearer idea of what God's Will is for our life. **First** of all, the better we get to know God—through prayer, scripture, and the sacraments—the better we are able to distinguish between what "is" of God and what "is not." **Second**, by developing a well-formed conscience, we can hear the voice of God from within. Trying to live a virtuous life develops that "little voice" inside that can help keep us on the right path. **Finally**, we can be assured that, if we choose to do what we truly believe is of God, what pleases God, and what leaves our conscience at peace, we have likely chosen what God would will for us. Does that mean that we can be positive that we have chosen the "one thing" that is God's will? Or, must we be afraid that we have chosen the wrong path, and God is up in heaven shaking his head? Of course not! All we can know for certain is that if this criteria has been met, then we have chosen well from one of the many good choices that could be God's Will for us.

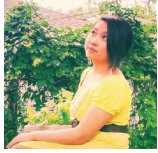

- ❖ **New** Coats, jackets, hats, gloves, mittens, boots, and snowpants (we will also accept clean, gently used coats, etc..)

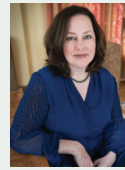
