The importance of the commandments is underlined in today's collect. Keeping them may give us eternal life! God thought humanity could just about handle ten rules, rules that, if kept, would simply life on the planet.

Humanity thought we could improve on them and multiply the rules. The further we move from the Ten Commandments the more rules we need. People flagrantly breaking the commandments complicate their lives horrendously. You can see that by just reading the papers.

But we hear people in important positions claiming they did nothing wrong as if bankrupting their businesses, their banks and their country or families was simply a breach of some Authority's regulations.

St Paul in today's reading says pray first 'for everyone' and goes on the mention those in authority, especially kings. Those who listen to the messages from Medjugorje hear the same request attributed to our Blessed Mother. Pray, pray, she is quoted repeatedly and 'especially for our shepherds for they are appointed by God.'

Recent commentaries on goings on in our church give the impression we should reform ourselves into a Godless church. A church that does not pray becomes contemptible and is treated with contempt.

The first Commandment is the one that makes it possible to keep the other precepts.

Today's Gospel is a call to focus, to concentrate on the main thing – God. Jesus is telling us to put God first. The Church goer is probably the only people to hear this. It is addressed to us in the first instance. If people do not see us as people of prayer it is unlikely they will join us in our worship.


HOSPITAL VISITATION: If you know of a parishioner who is sick and would like a visit please don't hesitate to contact one of the priests or the parish office.
