

FROM FR. MIKE:

In today's gospel, Matthew reports that during the transfiguration of Jesus, "his face shone like the sun." It reminds me of instances when a person has a certain glow about them where it is obvious they have had an encounter with Christ. This includes times when someone has just confessed their sins in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, is involved in learning more about their Catholic faith and growing in their spirituality, or when some of you when you are coming out of Mass. I believe that actively seeking to avail yourself to Christ inevitably fills you with his joy and enlightenment. A welcoming heart actively seeks to be present to and in the presence of Jesus, which can be scary because it also means we have to let go of being in control. When the voice from the bright cloud told the disciples to listen to Jesus, they were very much afraid. But to welcome Jesus to be in charge of our life is actually an easier way to live, and Jesus himself is encouraging us like the disciples to not be afraid. May we continue in this season of Lent to open up ourselves in God's care and share in the brilliant glory of his beloved Son.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Mateo relata que durante la transfiguración de Jesús "su rostro se puso resplandeciente como el sol." Me recuerda a los casos en que una persona tiene cierto resplandor sobre su cara donde es obvio que han tenido un encuentro con Cristo. Esto incluye tiempos en los que alguien acaba de confesar sus pecados en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación, está involucrado en aprender más acerca de su fe católica y crecer en su espiritualidad, o cuando algunos de ustedes están saliendo de Misa. Creo que la búsqueda activa a darse uno mismo a Cristo inevitablemente, nos llena de su alegría y su iluminación. Pastoral Team Visitation Report (Part 1)

Members of St. Joseph Parish visited our sister parish of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception in Mariani, Haiti Feb. 22-27 – Pierre and Barb Absi, Greg Heller, and Pierre's cousin George Suckarieh from Cincinnati.

Fr. Claudener Raphael and leaders in his parish have a master plan for a complex of buildings that uses the parish's 7.7 acres. Purchased in 2011 for \$253,000, the parish still owes \$23,000 on the land. He has the deed to the property registered in the name of the Archdiocese of Port-au-Prince.

The first building being constructed is used for Mass and other parish activities and has a footprint of 7000 sq.ft. It is made with cement blocks and will have a sheet metal roof when completed.

The walls for this building were going up during our visit and were built high enough to see the open spaces where the windows will be located. The total cost of this temporary church will be \$18,000. Of the \$8200 that was sent this time with the team, \$4000 will be used to buy the roofing materials.

Fr. Raphael projects that this will be completed in March 2018 and will hold 1000 persons.

Reporte de Visita del Equipo Pastoral (Parte 1)

Miembros de la Parroquia de San José visitaron nuestra parroquia hermana de Nuestra Señora de la Inmaculada Concepción en Mariani, Haití Feb. 22-27 - Pierre y Barb Absi, Greg Heller, y el primo de Pierre George Suckarieh de Cincinnati.


El Padre Claudener Raphael y los líderes en su parroquia tienen un plan maestro para un complejo de edificios que utilizará 7,7 acres de la parroquia. Comprado en el 2011 por \$253,000, la parroquia todavía debe \$23,000 en la tierra. Tiene la escritura de la propiedad registrada a nombre de la Arquidiócesis de Port-au-Prince.

El primer edificio que se construye se utiliza para la misa y otras actividades de la parroquia y tiene una medida de 7000 pies cuadrados. Está hecho con bloques de cemento y tendrá un techo de chapa metálica cuando esté terminado.

Las paredes de este edificio fueron subiendo durante nuestra visita y fueron construidas lo suficientemente alto para ver los espacios abiertos donde las ventanas se encuentran. El costo total de esta iglesia temporal será de \$18,000. De los \$8200 que se enviaron esta vez con el equipo, \$4000 se utilizarán para comprar los materiales para techos.

El Padre Raphael proyecta que esto se completará para marzo del 2018 y tendrá una capacidad de 1000 personas.
