FROM FR. MIKE:

Last week Jesus proclaimed, "I am the living water," and now this week he states, "I am the light of the world." These "I am" statements are spread throughout John's gospel to help us understand who Jesus is for us. As the light of the world, Jesus brings clarity to our lives by making things visible, as Paul mentions to the Ephesians in today's second reading. He also reminds them that "light produces every kind of goodness." So let me take this opportunity to make visible some goodness that has been coming from Christ in our parish, especially in the spirit of hospitality that we are striving to increase in our community. First, we continue to see more new people attending Mass, most of whom are returning to the church through your invitation and encouragement. Second, ministry is growing in our parish, particularly with a new music group that has served at the 11:30 Mass and with several people showing an interest in exploring ways we can have more outreach to our community. Finally, volunteers have helped set up a parish Facebook page to increase our presence on social media. As you can see, there are many good things that are making St. Joseph a light to our community and Jesus more visible in our midst.

Por último, los voluntarios han ayudado a crear una página Facebook de la parroquia para aumentar nuestra presencia en las redes sociales. Como pueden ver, hay muchas cosas buenas que están haciendo de San José una luz para nuestra comunidad y Jesús más visible en nuestro medio.

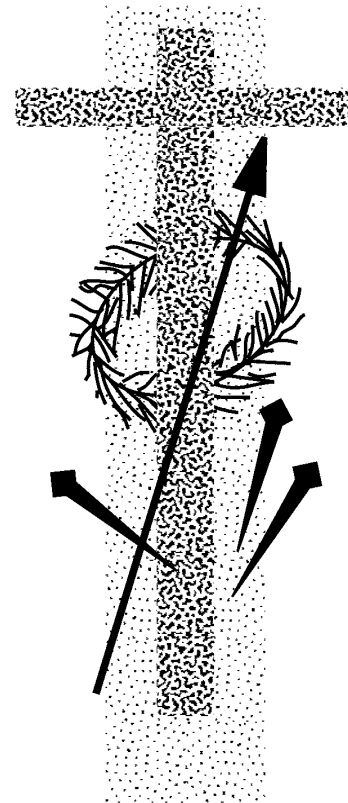

PASTORAL TEAM VISITATION REPORT (PART 3)

We met the two of the nurses and visited the clinic that rents space at the Palm Beach Hotel. The clinic is open Tuesday-Friday, 8:30am-3:00pm. Currently four nurses are working at the clinic, two on Tuesday and Thursday and two on Wednesday and Friday. The doctor comes for 2 ½ hours on Wednesday and Friday. Because the doctor oversees the clinic, they don't have to apply for a government permit to practice medicine. Each nurse is paid \$80 per month.

The exam and medicines are free to patients unless they need to buy from "the agency," where they are less expensive than the pharmacy. Eight to ten patients are seen daily, often for diabetes, high blood pressure, arthritis and gastro intestinal problems.

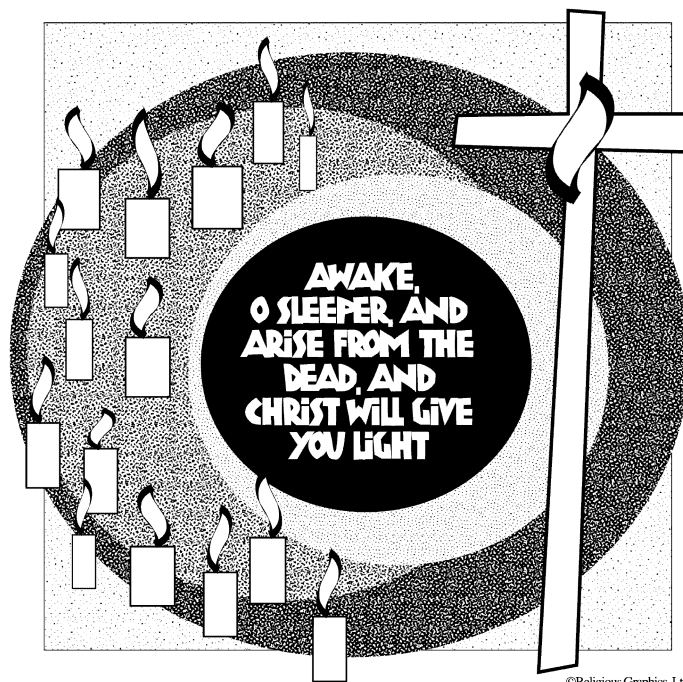

REPORTE DE VISITA DEL EQUIPO PASTORAL (PARTE 3)

Conocimos a las dos enfermeras y visitamos la clínica que alquila espacio en el Palm Beach Hotel. La clínica está abierta de martes a viernes, de 8:30 am a 3:00 pm. Actualmente cuatro enfermeras están trabajando en la clínica, dos el martes y jueves y dos el miércoles y viernes. El médico viene por 2 ½ horas el miércoles y el viernes. Debido a que el médico supervisa la clínica, no tienen que solicitar un permiso gubernamental para practicar la medicina. Cada enfermera es pagada \$80 por mes.

El examen y los medicamentos son gratuitos para los pacientes a menos que tengan que comprar de la "agencia," donde son menos costosos que la farmacia. Ocho a diez pacientes se ven diariamente, a menudo para la diabetes, presión alta, artritis y problemas gastrointestinales.
