



FROM FR. MIKE:

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord today, the First Reading describes Luke's version of Jesus being seated at God's right hand. He shares it at the very beginning of his Acts of the Apostles, which we could rename "The Gospel of Luke, Volume 2." We know these two books are connected because Luke starts both Acts and his gospel by addressing Theophilus, whose name means "Lover of God." Most scholars believe that instead of referring to a specific person, Luke is using this name to address anyone who is reading these books and who presumably loves God. This begs the question of whether we would qualify to have this nickname. For example, when our families will eventually write our obituaries, what will they say we loved-fishing or golf, bingo or reading, the Colts or the Cubs, or maybe our families or friends? If we are not sure they would include our love for God, especially through our participation in the church and our acts of service to the community, then perhaps this year's celebration of the Ascension is our wake-up call to reprioritize how we living our life to better make it a witness to the Gospel. The mandate from today's gospel from Matthew to baptize all nations and teach all to keep Christ's commandments to love could inform us on how to accomplish this. More specifically, it reminds us that we should be known for how we tried to share Jesus and his Gospel with others and not just for our favorite hobby or sports team.



DEL PADRE MIGUEL:

Al celebrar la Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor hoy, la Primera Lectura describe la versión de Lucas de que Jesús estaba sentado a la diestra de Dios. Él lo comparte al principio de sus Hechos de los Apóstoles, que podríamos cambiar el nombre "El Evangelio de Lucas, Volumen 2". Sabemos que estos dos libros están conectados porque Lucas comienza Hechos y su evangelio dirigiéndose a Teófilo, cuyo nombre significa "Amante de Dios". La mayoría de los estudiosos creen que, en lugar de referirse a una persona específica, Lucas está usando este nombre para dirigirse a cualquiera que esté levendo estos libros y que presumiblemente ama a Dios. Esto plantea la cuestión de si calificaríamos para tener este apodo. Por ejemplo, cuando nuestras familias eventualmente escriban nuestros obituarios, ¿qué dirán que amamos: ¿El futbol o las novelas, las fiestas o los convivios, Las Chivas o El Real Madrid, o guizás nuestras familias o amigos? Si no estamos seguros de que incluirían nuestro amor por Dios, especialmente a través de nuestra participación en la iglesia y nuestros actos de servicio a la comunidad, entonces tal vez la celebración de este año de la Ascensión es nuestro despertar para volver a priorizar cómo vivimos nuestra vida Para que sea un testimonio del Evangelio. El mandato del evangelio de hoy de Mateo para bautizar a todas las naciones y enseñar a todos a guardar los mandamientos de Cristo al amor podría informarnos sobre cómo lograr esto. Más específicamente, nos recuerda que debemos ser conocidos por cómo hemos tratado de compartir a Jesús y su Evangelio con los demás y no sólo para nuestro pasatiempo favorito o equipo deportivo.
