

FROM FR. MIKE:

The Sunday following the celebration of Pentecost is today's solemnity of the Holy Trinity. I find this celebration a helpful reminder about who God is and who we are. If God is three persons but still one God, then the inner reality of God is one of relationship. We are made in God's likeness, so thus we are only fully human when we are in good relationship with God. It also means we are only fulfilled in life when we are fully engaged in our relationships with others. If this is the very nature of God, it means he wants us to know and receive his love, which is the ultimate goal of any person who wants a good relationship with another person. So when we fully accept God's love for us, it makes our ability to love others so much better. While it seems easier at times to withdraw from others because relationships are complicated, it makes our lives empty and certainly less than what God has designed for us. This inner reality of God, who is one in substance yet three persons in loving relationship, is also what compels us as Christians to reach out to the poor and those who do not have a church or a developed faith to be a part of our faith community. It would be easier for us to just deal with whomever approaches us, but this is not how we envision our mission of sharing the Gospel, and certainly not reflective of the Trinitarian nature of God. May we who pray in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit strive always to live out the Trinity in our own lives by becoming more connected to God and in loving relationships with others.



DEL PADRE MIGUEL:

El domingo que sigue después de la celebración de Pentecostés es la solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Encuentro esta celebración un útil recordatorio de quién es Dios y quiénes somos nosotros. Si Dios es tres personas pero todavía un Dios, entonces la realidad interna de Dios es una relación. Somos hechos a la semejanza de Dios, por lo tanto, solo somos plenamente humanos cuando estamos en buena relación con Dios. También significa que sólo estamos totalmente contentos con la vida cuando estamos plenamente comprometidos con nuestras relaciones con los demás. Si esta es la naturaleza misma de Dios, significa que quiere que conozcamos y recibamos su amor, que es el objetivo último de cualquier persona que quiera una buena relación con otra persona. Así que cuando aceptamos plenamente el amor de Dios por nosotros, hace que nuestra capacidad de amar a los demás sea mucho mejor. Aunque a veces parece más fácil retirarse de los demás porque las relaciones son complicadas, hace que nuestras vidas estén vacías y ciertamente menos de lo que Dios ha diseñado para nosotros. Esta realidad interior de Dios, que es uno en sustancia, pero tres personas en relación amorosa, es también lo que nos obliga como cristianos a llegar a los pobres y aquellos que no tienen una iglesia o una fe desarrollada para ser parte de nuestra fe en comunidad. Sería más fácil para nosotros tratar con quien se nos acerque, pero no es así como imaginamos nuestra misión de compartir el Evangelio y ciertamente no es el reflejo de la naturaleza trinitaria de Dios. Que nosotros, que oramos en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, nos esforcemos siempre por vivir la Trinidad en nuestras propias vidas al relacionarnos más con Dios y en las relaciones amorosas con los demás.
