FROM FR. MIKE:

Part of what it means to be a welcoming parish means that we are an inviting parish. This may go against our own personality type, and it may not be the way we normally think of ourselves as Catholics. If there is one thing Pope Francis talks about frequently, it is the need to continue to engage in the New Evangelization, a term that was first coined by St. John Paul II. While evangelization has always been the primary mission of the church, the part that is new is that there is an urgency about sharing the faith with those around us and especially the next generation of teens and young adults. As we live in the midst of a much more secularized society than in past decades, there is a much larger number of people who are not just fallen away from church but who were never part of a faith community to begin with. A simple invitation to someone to accompany you to Mass is an example of this new evangelization. Another is that you could inquire a neighbor or coworker if there is anything going on in their life or with their family for which you can offer prayers. A simple invitation or brief request can go a long way to bringing others to Christ. In the words of today's gospel, we are sowing seeds by sharing in a non-threatening way our faith. Eventually we sow enough of these seeds that others in our midst will grow in their spirituality and in their relationship with Jesus such that, as St. Matthew tells us, they will produce yields of "a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold."

DEL PADRE MIGUEL:

Parte de lo que significa ser una parroquia acogedora significa que somos una parroquia invitadora. Esto puede ir en contra de nuestro tipo de personalidad, y puede que no sea la forma en que normalmente pensamos de nosotros mismos como católicos. Si hay una cosa de la que el Papa habla frecuentemente, es la necesidad de seguir participando en la Nueva Evangelización, término que fue acuñado por San Juan Pablo II. Aunque la evangelización siempre ha sido la misión primordial de la iglesia, la parte nueva es que hay una urgencia de compartir la fe con quienes nos rodean y especialmente con la próxima generación de adolescentes y adultos jóvenes. A medida que vivimos en medio de una sociedad mucho más secularizada que en décadas pasadas, hay un número mucho mayor de personas que no sólo se han alejado de la iglesia, pero que nunca fueron parte de una comunidad de fe para empezar. Una simple invitación a alguien que lo acompañe a la misa es un ejemplo de esta nueva evangelización. Otra es que usted podría preguntar a un vecino o compañero de trabajo si hay algo que pasa en su vida o con su familia para la que puede ofrecer oraciones. Una invitación sencilla o breve solicitud puede ir a un largo camino para llevar a otros a Cristo. En las palabras del evangelio de hoy, estamos sembrando semillas compartiendo de una manera no amenazante nuestra fe. Eventualmente sembramos bastantes de estas semillas que otros en nuestro medio crecerán en su espiritualidad y en su relación con Jesús de tal manera que, como San Mateo nos dice, producirán rendimientos de "unos, ciento por uno; otros, sesenta; y otros, treinta."

MISTY MENIS-KYLER MISSIONARY UPDATE

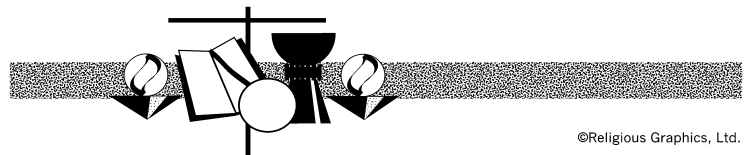
