SUNDAY READINGS

To better prepare yourself to listen to the word of the Lord for next Sunday, please read and meditate on the readings this week, they are: 1 Kings 3:5,7-12 Solomon asks for, and is granted, a wise heart. Romans 8:23-30 "All things work for good for those who love God." Matthew 13:44-52 Jesus offers more parables about the kingdom of heaven.

A SHORT REFLECTION

The disciples ask Jesus for an explanation of the parable of the weeds. Again, as in the parable of the sower. Jesus gives them a point by point explanation, giving the parable an apocalyptic meaning. On the most basic level the apocalyptic interpretation promises that evil will not win in the end. But, the way good will win does not necessarily reflect human judgment. The disciples are not called to police the kingdom. The Son of Man will send the angels to do the sifting when harvest time comes. The disciples need only sow seeds and mix yeast; with just that effort the kingdom promises to sprout like weeds.

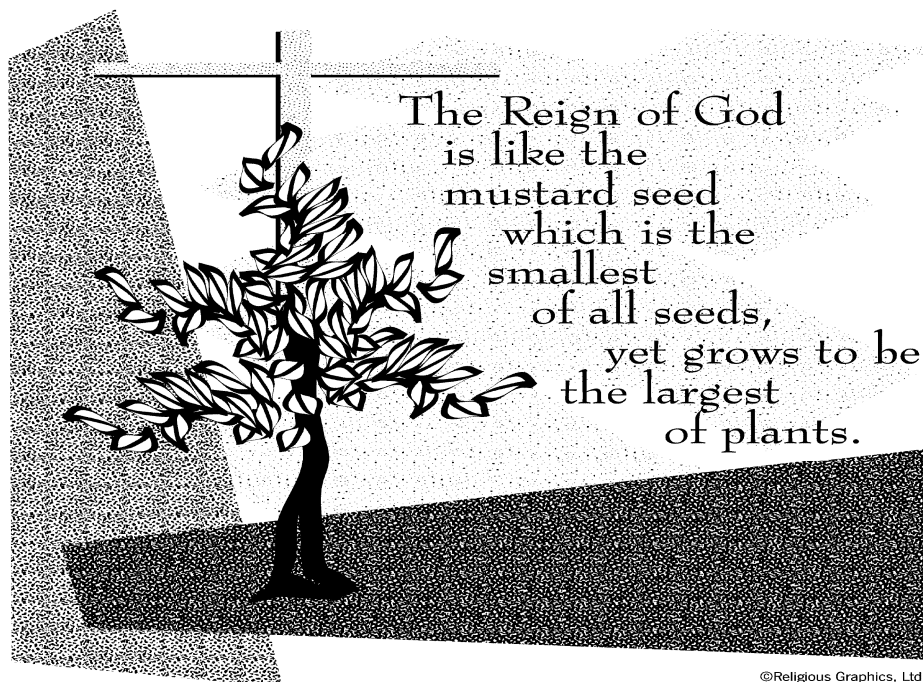
