#### FROM FR. MIKE:

This week each year the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), which is basically the official voice and organizing institution of the Catholic Church in this country, invites us to a greater awareness of Natural Family Planning (NFP). See the insert in this bulletin for a wonderful witness of one of the many benefits of this method. What I have come to appreciate about NFP is that it shows how the church always has a holistic approach to our lives. In this case, when a married couple is in tune with the natural rhythms of a woman's body as God has designed her, then the bond is stronger between them in all aspects of their marriage, not just the physical. In everyday language, the romance can remain strong and even grow because a couple is connected on all levels of their relationship. It is no surprise, then, that the divorce rate for NFP couples is a tenth of the rate of the overall population. Especially when you consider how much NFP enhances communication among spouses, it is not just a method of addressing fertility but a way of increasing the closeness a couple experiences in their married love. As today's first reading from the Book of Wisdom says to God, "For you show your might when the perfection of your power is disbelieved," so does God show his power through the multiple benefits of NFP even though it is widely misunderstood and disbelieved.

Esta semana de cada año la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB), que es básicamente la voz oficial y la institución organizadora de la Iglesia Católica en este país, nos invita a una mayor conciencia de la Planificación Natural Familiar (NFP). Vea la inserción en este boletín para un testimonio maravilloso de uno de los muchos beneficios de este método. Lo que he llegado a apreciar acerca del NFP es que muestra cómo la iglesia siempre tiene un enfoque holístico de nuestras vidas. En este caso, cuando un matrimonio está en sintonía con los ritmos naturales del cuerpo de una mujer como Dios la ha diseñado, entonces el vínculo es más fuerte entre ellos en todos los aspectos de su matrimonio, no sólo en lo físico. En el lenguaje cotidiano, el romance puede seguir siendo fuerte e incluso crecer porque una pareja está conectada en todos los niveles de su relación. No es ninguna sorpresa, entonces, que la tasa de divorcio para las parejas NFP es una décima parte de la población en general. Especialmente cuando se considera cuánto la NFP mejora la comunicación entre los cónyuges, no es sólo un método de abordar la fertilidad, sino una manera de aumentar la cercanía de una pareja en su amor casado. Como la primera lectura de hoy del Libro de la Sabiduría dice a Dios: "Muestras tu poder cuando la de la perfección de tu poder es incrédula", también Dios muestra su poder a través de los múltiples beneficios de la NFP. aunque es ampliamente malentendido e incrédulo.

Fr. Raphael recently shared with us that at our sister parish in Mariani, later this month, they will be holding a retreat for their Kiro group (Catholic version of Boy Scouts) for youth ages 8-16. With games, food, discussions, and faith formation, the retreat is expected to last 5 days for about 80 persons. In August, about 25 young adults, ages 18-28, are traveling to eastern Haiti for a 5 day retreat focusing on the Catholic faith as they prepare to attend college, consider marriage, and discern other vocations.


The next gathering of those interested in helping our parish determine how we will increase our service outreach to our local community is Sat, Jul. 29, 9:00am in the Parish Hall.
