FROM FR. MIKE:

One of the challenges of living the Christian life is that there are no shortcuts. Today's gospel reminds us of one way we may try to do this. In the parable, the foolish virgins come unprepared for the bridegroom's arrival, not thinking ahead that he might come during the nighttime. It seems like the five wise virgins are rude for not sharing their oil once he arrives. The fact they are called "wise virgins" hints that this story is not about being nice through sharing but that each person is responsible for their own readiness in faith. One shortcut we may like to take is that we rely on others' faith or goodness as adequate for our own life. No one can replace the effort we each have to put into our relationship with Christ. For example, we cannot rely on being raised Catholic throughout our childhood but then not continue to learn about our faith as an adult. Nor can we think that having a parent or grandparent who practiced the faith is adequate when we ourselves may not pray the rosary regularly nor spend time with the Bible like they modeled for us. It would be nice if just being related to or hanging around other holy people would be all it takes to enjoy the fullness of God's grace. But only the wise know that, like any relationship, it takes ongoing effort for our hearts to be ready for the coming of the Lord, especially when we "know neither the day nor the hour."

DEL PADRE MIGUEL:

Uno de los desafíos de vivir la vida cristiana es que no hay atajos. El evangelio de hoy nos recuerda una forma en que podemos tratar de hacer esto. En la parábola, las vírgenes insensatas no están preparadas para la llegada del novio, sin pensar que vendrá durante la noche. Parece que las cinco vírgenes sabías son groseras por no compartir su aceite una vez que llega. El hecho de que se les llame "vírgenes sabías" insinúa que esta historia no trata sobre ser amable al compartir, sino que cada persona es responsable de su propia disposición en la fe. Un atajo que nos gustaría tomar es que dependemos de la fe o bondad de los demás adecuadamente para nuestra propia vida. Nadie puede reemplazar el esfuerzo que cada uno tiene que poner en nuestra relación con Cristo. Por ejemplo, no podemos confiar en ser criados como católicos durante toda nuestra niñez, pero luego no continuar aprendiendo acerca de nuestra fe como adultos. Tampoco podemos pensar que tener un padre o abuelo que practica la fe es adecuado cuando nosotros mismos no podemos rezar el rosario regularmente ni pasar tiempo con la Biblia como modelaron para nosotros. Sería bueno si simplemente relacionarse con otras personas santas o quedarse con otras personas santas sería todo lo que se necesita para disfrutar la plenitud de la gracia de Dios. Pero solo los sabios saben que, como cualquier relación, requiere un esfuerzo constante para que nuestros corazones estén listos para la venida del Señor, especialmente cuando "no sabemos ni el día ni la hora".

APLICACIONES DE LA CESTA DE ALIMENTOS DE NAVIDAD

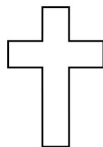

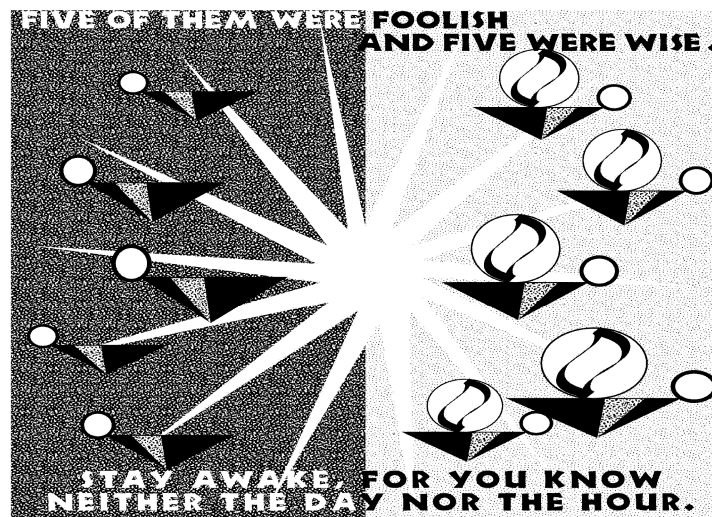
