From Father Mike

Today's first reading ends with a fascinating line from the prophet Jeremiah: "...for I will forgive their evildoing and remember their sin no more." We remember that Jeremiah was around during the Babylonian exile, where the sins of the Jews were so egregious that they lost their homeland and were held captive in a foreign territory. But even in this Old Testament passage we get a sense of the wideness of God's mercy and his desire to have a permanent relationship with us that is ultimately fulfilled by Jesus through his crucifixion and resurrection. Jeremiah is reminding us of God's amnesia when it comes to our sins. His mercy is such that he only sees us as his beloved children, and the only aspect of our past that he wants to address is that we are not held back by it in the present, which is what forgiveness does. While we can be good at holding grudges or clinging to past hurts, God simply wants us to be liberated from previous failings and protected from all evil in the present. If you have trouble believing this, remember he was willing to sacrifice his only Son to establish this permanent covenant. While we call this Good News, it can seem too good to be true. That is why the prophets like Jeremiah proclaim it to us anyway because our difficulty in believing this does not make it any less true!

La primera lectura de hoy termina con una línea fascinante del profeta Jeremías: "... porque perdonaré sus maldades y no recordaré más su pecado." Recordamos que Jeremías estuvo presente durante el exilio en Babilonia, donde los pecados de los judíos eran tan atroces que perdieron su tierra natal y fueron mantenidos cautivos en un territorio extranjero. Pero incluso en este pasaje del Antiguo Testamento obtenemos un sentido de la amplitud de la misericordia de Dios y su deseo de tener una relación permanente con nosotros que finalmente se cumple por medio de Jesús a través de su crucifixión y resurrección. Jeremías nos recuerda la amnesia de Dios cuando se trata de nuestros pecados. Su misericordia es tal que solo nos ve como sus amados hijos, y el único aspecto de nuestro pasado que quiere abordar es que no nos contenga en el presente, que es lo que hace el perdón. Si bien podemos ser buenos guardando rencillas o aferrándonos a las heridas pasadas, Dios simplemente quiere que nos liberemos de fallas previas y nos protejamos de todo mal en el presente. Si tienen problemas para creer en esto, recuerden que estaba dispuesto a sacrificar a su único Hijo para establecer este pacto permanente. Si bien la llamamos La Buena Nueva, puede parecer demasiado bueno para ser verdad. ¡Es por eso que los profetas como Jeremías nos lo proclaman de todos modos porque nuestra dificultad para creer esto no lo hace menos cierto!

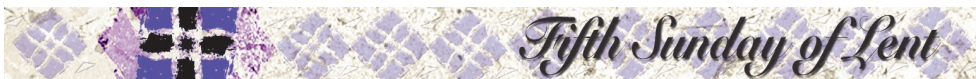


