From Father Mike

Even though we experience the proclamation of the crucifixion of Jesus for today's gospel reading, is it notable that we call today Palm Sunday. Some would say that it is because of the free souvenir we get to take home from church. But more accurate would be that everything we do as Catholics happens through the lens of the resurrection of Jesus. So the triumphal entrance into Jerusalem by Jesus, symbolized by today's palms, reminds us to begin with the end in mind, namely that even though Christ suffered the cruel death of the cross, God ultimately conquered sin and death when he raised Jesus from the dead. The church at Bethpage in the Holy Land has a chapel built at the spot of the beginning of Jesus' going to the city (about a mile outside of Jerusalem), and inside is the rock from which he stepped up on and then mounted the donkey for his journey. Today is the rock from which we launch our Holy Week journey, mindful of our need to follow our Messiah through both his dying and rising from the dead. So as the Palm Sunday Mass begins with the procession with palms, so we remember that no matter what is happening in our life, including our own suffering or sinfulness, that we walk with Jesus and join him in both his passion and ultimate triumph of the resurrection.

Del Padre Miguel

Aunque experimentamos la proclamación de la crucifixión de Jesús para la lectura del evangelio de hoy, es notable que hoy se llame Domingo de Ramos. Algunos dirán que es por el recuerdo de la Palma que nos llevaremos a casa. Pero más exacto sería que todo lo que hacemos como católicos sucede a través de la resurrección de Jesús. Entonces, la entrada triunfal en Jerusalén por Jesús, que es simbolizada por las palmas de hoy, nos recuerda a comenzar con el final en mente, es decir que aunque Cristo sufrió la cruel muerte de la cruz, finalmente Dios conquistó el pecado y la muerte cuando resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos. La iglesia en Betfagé en Tierra Santa tiene una capilla construida en el punto del comienzo de la partida de Jesús a la ciudad (a una milla de Jerusalén), y adentro está la roca desde la cual subió y luego montó el burro para su viaje. Hoy es la roca desde la cual lanzamos nuestro viaje de Semana Santa, conscientes de nuestra necesidad de seguir a nuestro Mesías a través de su muerte y resurrección de entre los muertos. Así que cuando la Misa del Domingo de Ramos comienza con la procesión con las palmas, recordamos que no importa lo que esté sucediendo en nuestra vida, incluido nuestro propio sufrimiento o pecaminosidad, caminamos con Jesús y nos unimos a él tanto en su pasión como en el triunfo final del Resurrección.

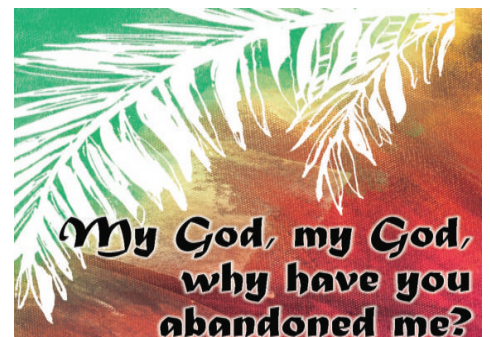
PESCADO Y POLLO FRITO
