FROM FR. MIKE:

There has been some controversy ever since St. John Paul II made today, the Second Sunday of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday. I believe the difficulty is with a narrow concept of mercy, which is often equated with the forgiveness of sin. This need for forgiveness can feel like a continuation on the focus on penance, and so there are those resistant to having the Easter Octave end on what seems to be a continuation of Lent. While forgiveness is an important element of mercy, as confirmed in this Sunday's gospel when Jesus imparts the power to forgive on the church, it goes well beyond it. As we learned during the Jubilee Year during 2016, mercy is God's tender care for those who struggle with just how unconditional is the Father's love for us. When Thomas expresses his doubt about Jesus' resurrection, he speaks for any of us who have experience a time when we are uncertain about God's limitless love, his desire to heal us, or even his very existence. This is why our making continued contact with the unchurched or fallen-away is an important part of our welcoming atmosphere as a parish. Just because people report unbelief or skepticism about religion doesn't mean Jesus isn't trying to break through the upper room of their minds and hearts in order to touch them. As his mercy is untiring, so can our outreach be an ongoing part of our wonderful family of faith.



DEL PADRE MIGUEL:

Ha habido alguna controversia desde que San Juan Pablo II hizo este día, el domingo segundo de la Pascua, el domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Creo que la dificultad de esta controversia es de un concepto estrecho de la misericordia, que a menudo se compara con el perdón del pecado. Esta necesidad de perdón puede sentirse como una continuación del enfoque en la penitencia, y por lo tanto hay aquellos resistentes a que la Octava de Pascua termine en lo que parece ser una continuación de la Cuaresma. Mientras que el perdón es un elemento importante de la misericordia, como se confirma en el evangelio de este domingo, cuando Jesús transmite el poder de perdonar a la iglesia. Como aprendimos durante el Año del Jubileo durante el 2016, la misericordia es el cuidado tierno de Dios para aquellos que luchan con lo incondicional que es el amor del Padre por nosotros. Cuando Tomas expresa su duda acerca de la resurrección de Jesús, él habla para cualquiera de nosotros que hemos tenido una experiencia en que no estamos seguros acerca del amor ilimitado de Dios, su deseo de curarnos o incluso su propia existencia. Esta es la razón por la que mantener un contacto continuo con los sin iglesia o caídos es una parte importante de nuestro ambiente acogedor como parroquia. El hecho de que las personas denuncien la incredulidad o el escepticismo con respecto a la religión no significa que Jesús no está tratando de entrar en sus mentes y corazones para tocarlos. Como su misericordia es infatigable, también puede ser nuestro alcance a los demás una parte continua de nuestra maravillosa familia de fe.

PASTORAL TEAM VISITATION REPORT (PART 7)

We attended Mass daily with 40-80 parishioners at 6:30 am. The Mass on Sunday was at 8:00am with over 600 parishioners in attendance. It was cut short to two hours in length in order to allow our team to have time to meet with the Pastoral Council. This council represents music ministries, liturgy, faith formation and education, finance, and the building chief. The Parish Council is made up of approximately 25 persons, some representing the following groups:
